## CAMP PROGRAM

This is the camp for the soccer player who strives to be the best player they can be, for the player who aspires to play – and make an impact – on their high school team, for the player who dreams of playing at the college level and beyond. Rick Benben's UMKC Soccer Camps give both boys and girls the opportunity to improve all aspects of their individual game as well as their concept of team tactics. Players will be grouped by age and skill level. Goalkeepers will receive special training. A ratio of one coach to every 10 campers is used.

With the help of the UMKC Coaching Staff, other college coaches, area high school coaches, and current college players, Rick Benben has developed a camp program that is second to none. Join us and improve your game in a safe, competitive, and enjoyable environment.

## CAMP LOCATION

### University of Missouri - Kansas City Kansas City, Missouri

Campers are accommodated on campus at UMKC in the suites of **Johnson Residence Hall**. The four person suites include a full private bathroom, refrigerator, microwave, internet service, and cable television. Camp staff will monitor the dormitory and escort players to and from each meal and field session.

Training and games are conducted at the **Stan Durwood Soccer Stadium and Recreational Field**. This \$9M facility opened in 2009 and has quickly become the center of campus life at UMKC. The playing field is an artificial surface surrounded by a four lane jogging track. Indoor training, futsal, and swimming take place just steps away in the Swinney Recreation Center.

In twelve seasons at the helm of UMKC Soccer, Head Coach Rick Benben has left a lasting impression on the direction of the program. The Kangaroos have registered victories over several nationally ranked opponents, claimed three Conference Championships, made three NCAA Tournament appearances and are aiming to build on their success. UMKC soccer players have received numerous individual honors for both academic and athletic achievements.

## CAMP INFORMATION

**THE DAILY SCHEDULE** includes three on-field sessions. One of these sessions each day is devoted to team competition. Free time recreation activities include swimming, game room, snack bar, and other recreation facilities on campus. Staff provides 24 hour supervision, in addition to security provided by UMKC. There is an athletic trainer on duty.

**EACH CAMPER** will receive a complimentary ball at check-in. Size 4 (Ages 9-11) and Size 5 (Ages 12 & up) are available. All campers will also receive a camp T-shirt.

**THE RESIDENT FEE of \$440** includes room, all meals: dinner on the first night through breakfast on the last day, use of college facilities, camp shirt, and ball. Camp check-in is from **4-5 PM** on the first day of camp. Check-out is after the morning session at Noon on the last day.

**THE COMMUTER FEE of \$325** includes all meals except breakfast, use of college facilities, camp shirt and ball. Commuters check in from **4-5PM** the first day of camp, with dinner and instruction given until 9 PM. The normal commuter's day begins at 8:30 AM and ends at approximately 9 PM, except for the last day when checkout is at Noon.

**FAMILY AND TEAM DISCOUNTS ARE AVAILABLE.** The discount for a second or third child from the same family is \$15 each. If a group of six or more from the same club team signs up for camp, each player can take a \$15 discount. Only one discount per player.

**A NON-REFUNDABLE DEPOSIT OF \$75** must be forwarded with a completed application to insure enrollment. The balance of the fee is due two weeks prior to the opening day of camp. On receipt of your application, you will receive information about what to bring to camp as well as a detailed map & medical authorization form. Forms are also available on the website.
